Time Commitment

Leadership Santa Maria Valley (LSMV) is a hands-on program integrating regional orientations, academic sessions, and a wide range of active leadership opportunities. Although the majority of the program takes place on the Friday topic days, participants are expected to fully participate in all parts of the program.

To ensure participants and their employers have a good understanding of the various activities and time commitments, below is an overview.

- Initial program interview: Approximately a one-hour meeting to discuss the LSMV program and ensure it is a good fit.
- Welcome Reception: Opportunity to meet class members, LSMV board members, and discuss the upcoming retreat.
- Retreat: A Friday afternoon to Sunday afternoon retreat focusing on team building and leadership skills.
- Topic Days:
 - Usually, the first Friday of every month, class members explore a specific regional topic and receive training in a leadership topic. Expect topic days to run 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. Due to orientation opportunities, topic days may start at 7:30 am. Topic days are busy with very limited breaks. Working lunches are the standard. Topic days are not the same as a standard work day.
 - **Do not expect to complete work-related activities during topic days.**
 - Each class member will be involved in planning at least two topic days. Planning activities are outside of regular LSMV events. Planning involves coordinating all activities that will take place during the Topic Day. Planning should start at least 2-months before the topic day and the first meeting will be done in-person with advisors.
- Legacy Project: The class will develop and execute a legacy class project that will be completed before graduation. Class members will be required to coordinate and execute all aspects of the project from theme, location, funding, resources...
- Mid-year retreat: A half-day retreat focused on planning the Legacy Project. This is usually done at a class member's home or business.
- Life Story: Each class member will provide a brief 5-10 min life story.
- Graduation: A ceremony celebrating the culmination of your LSMV program. Immediate family members and your supervisor are invited.

I understand LSMV is focused on developing my leadership skills and understanding of the region. As a class member, I am expected to engage and support all class activities and planning efforts.
